Societies

We are proud to be home to a host of faith, academic, cultural and common interest/recreational societies run by students for students. Activities can range from speaker sessions with the Aviation society, charity bake off's and external speaker events with the Midwifery society, revision support from the Paramedic society to building social enterprises with the Enactus Bedfordshire society.

The past year has led to a lot of our societies having to meet in the virtual space, enabling people from across campuses to come together. While we are looking forward to more face-to-face socials in the year ahead, we are hopeful opportunities to join some sessions virtually will continue, allowing more students to get involved in the hobbies or interests that matter to them.



Student Voice

Discover the variety of ways in which you can use your student voice.

At the heart of what we do is ensuring we give our students the opportunity to have their voices heard.

We want to hear your views on how your student experience is going at University, to your thoughts or topical nationwide student matters you feel we can support you on.

We have made a number of key changes in the past year to streamline the way in which you can feedback from sharing your comments online, attending forums or in person to the students that represent you.

While we are independent from the university, we work in partnership with them to improve your experience.



There are so many ways for you to have your student voice heard with us. You can put questions to your elected Exec Officers, either via email, in person or via Union Parliament, where you can also share your ideas and concerns or even propose new policies, start a campaign. You can also vote in our student elections and join a Student Network and play your part in creating lasting change for under-represented groups.

Student Networks

We have three specialist networks focused on raising awareness and championing change for students who are widely acknowledged to experience or have experienced oppression, exclusion or disadvantage:

- Students with Disabilities Network
- Black and Minority Ethnic Students' Network
- Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans*, Plus (LGBT+) Students' Networks

These networks are run by individuals in your student community who have a passion for championing the voice of their fellow members. The networks are open to any student who self-indentifies as having the characteristics. You can find out more details on how to join or attend events on the Beds SU website.



Campus Reps

Our team of dedicated Campus Reps are on hand to support you and help make changes for you and your campus. They are elected students who work closely with the Exec Officers to ensure students on all campuses get the most out of their student experience. Academic Reps

Our elected Academic Reps champion and support all students and we are proud to support them in representing you and your academic needs. Your Academic Reps are your fellow students, elected in these voluntary positions to support your Exec Officers in championing for change. They work in partnership with the SU and the University to enhance the experience of their fellow learners. Events


We're here for you wherever you are.


Here at Beds SU we have a team of caring, dedicated individuals who are on hand to provide students with free, impartial and confidential advice and support on a variety of aspects of student life.
